In 2019, the Department of Education, Skills and Employment commissioned dandolo to review the implementation of the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education Students. The review mapped implementation of the test to date and made recommendations to the Australian Government on

the test's possible future directions and ongoing implementation. The review included consultation with Education departments, Teacher Regulatory Authorities (TRAs), HEPs and Initial Teacher Education (ITE) students. The Department then commissioned dandolo to undertake further sector consultation on three select recommendations from the implementation review, and seek feedback on key implementation and design issues. This report
