explain things are always found in immanent concepts, universals or kinds. And he will argue from here to conclusions which are distinctive in being metaphysically ambitious yet surprisingly distant from any form of metaphysical foundationalism, whether scientific, theological, or otherwise. Hegel's project, then, turns out neither Kantian nor Spinozist, but more

distinctively his own.
