UK + US terms incl. crochet diagram You need to know how to crochet: UK: chain stitch, single crochet, double crochet, treble crochet, half treble crochet, crochet in a round US: chain stitch, slip stitch, single

crochet, double crochet, half double crochet, crochet in a round You need 4 ply yarn, 200g = 3,5 oz, ca. 800m/ca. 876 yards for size S (Original: Rellana Regenbogen; color number 8 Flamenco, available at Rellana), for size M you need 4 ply yarn ca. 250g and/or ca. 1000m/ca. 1094 yards, for every higher size you need 50g more yarn.

Author Ieva Ozolina has designed a range of accessories featuring traditional Latvian motifs and design elements such as Latvian braids to create this beautiful collection. The wider variety of projects and styles will give this title broad appeal and the accessibility of some of the projects such as the wraps and scarves make them suitable for less

experienced knitters while the more detailed patterns for gloves will appeal to more experienced knitters. The size of the smaller projects means they don't use very much yarn and they make very portable projects for when you're on the move. Knit Like a Latvian Accessories also looks at the stories behind the design motifs which are steeped in folk tradition - for example, if you include the sun motif design in your knitting it is thought that the item will offer extra warmth to the wearer - so you can understand the traditions behind the knitting.

Typical Alpine Dirndl dresses tell us lots about the wearer - like, which region she comes from and if she's married or not - and also the socks and stockings worn in traditional Alpine clothing tell details about the wearer. In earlier times, each village had its own stitch patterns for socks! I hope you'll enjoy my compilation of knitting patterns for Alpine socks and

stockings!
