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The Derivation of VO and OV takes a new look at the relationship between head-final or OV structures and head-initial or VO ones, in light of recent work by Richard Kayne and others. The various papers in the volume take different positions with respect to whether one type of structure is derived from the other, and if so, which of the two orders is primary. Different options explored include derivation of VO order by head movement from a basic OV structure, derivation of VO by fronting of a phrasal VP remnant containing only the verb, derivation of OV by fronting of a remnant VP which the verb has vacated, and others. Each paper is thoroughly rooted in empirical observations about specific constructions drawn either from the Germanic languages or from others including Finnish, Hungarian, Japanese, and Malagasy. The volume consists of eleven original papers by Sjef Barbiers, Michael Brody, Naoki Fukui & Yuji Takano, Liliane Haegeman, Hubert Haider, Roland Hinterhölzl, Anders Holmberg, Thorbjorg Hróarsdóttir, Matthew Pearson, Peter Svenonius, and Knut Tarald Taraldsen, plus an introduction by the editor.

Diese longitudinale angelegte Studie im Bereich Deutsch als Fremdsprache untersucht die Entwicklung der Deutschkenntnisse ungarischer Schülerinnen und Schüler anhand schriftlicher Lernertexte. Der Fokus liegt neben dem aktiven Wortschatz und den Kohäsionsmitteln auf der Entwicklung der morphologisch-syntaktischen Sprachebene, d.h. auf den Erwerbsequenzen. Um ein möglichst vollständiges Bild über die fremdsprachliche Entwicklung zu erhalten, wird die Lernalterspra sowohl unter dem Aspekt der Komplexität als auch dem der Grammatikalität untersucht. Die Einbeziehung umfangreicher sekundärer Daten (wie Sprachlernbiographie, Lernstrategien und Sprachstandtests) ermöglichen die Verknüpfung von linguistischen Daten und individuellen Lernerprofilen. Die Ergebnisse aus unterschiedlichen Analyseverfahren werden zusammengefasst und integriert, sodass sich eine übergreifende Sicht auf die lernaltersprachliche Entwicklung und mögliche didaktische Konsequenzen ergeben. Olga Fekete, Dr. phil., studierte Lehramt für die Fächer Latein und Deutsch (Sekundarstufe I und II) in Ungarn. Anschließend absolvierte sie das Aufbaustudium für Sprachlehrforschung an der Westfälischen Wilhelms-Universität Münster und arbeitete dort bis 2012. Seit 2013 ist sie als wissenschaftliche Mitarbeiterin an der Universität Paderborn (Deutsch als Zweitsprache/Germanistik) tätig. Ihre Forschungsinteressen sind Sprach- und Fachlernen im Kontext von Mehrsprachigkeit sowie Schreiben in der Fremd- und Zweitsprache.

Linguists have standardly assumed that grammar is about identifying all and only the 'good' sentences of a language, which implies that there must be other, 'bad' sentences- but in practice most linguists know that it is hard to pin those down. The standard assumption is no more than an assumption. A century ago, grammarians did not think about their subject that way, and our book shows that the older idea was right: linguists can and should dispense with the concept 'starred sentence'. We draw on corpus data in order to support a different model of grammar, in which

individuals refine positive grammatical habits to greater or lesser extents in diverse and unpredictable directions, but nothing is ever ruled out.

Languages are not merely alternative methods of verbalizing universal logical forms. We use empirical evidence to shed light on the routes by which school-age children gradually expand their battery of grammatical resources, which turn out to be sometimes counter-intuitive. Our rejection of the 'starred sentence' concept has attracted considerable discussion, and we summarize the reactions and respond to our critics. The contrasting models of grammar described in this book entail contrasting pictures of human nature; our closing chapter shows that grammatical theory is not value-neutral but has an ethical dimension.
