 Barthélémy Toguo is a multiple disciplinary artist whose work addresses migration, colonialism, race, exile and displacement. Born in 1967 in Cameroon, he lives and works between Bandjoun and Paris. After studying at the fine arts academy in Abidjan, Ivory Coast, Toguo made his way to the fine arts academy in Grenoble, then the Kunstakademie in Düsseldorf. Freely encompassing drawing,

sculpture, video, installation and performance, his creations draw inspiration from his experience, travels and encounters. Watercolour has a central place in his work. Toguo plays with the spaces where different materials overlap. He created pathways between Western and African traditions and observes the language and new identities that arise therein. Hooray for Fall! Chronicle Books

"In the United States, Raymond Queneau (1903-1976) is known mainly for his novel *Zazie dans le metro*, which was made into a film by Louis Malle, for *Exercices in Style*, and for being the founder and one of the most important members of the literary movement known as Oulipo. In France and much of Europe Queneau is known for his prolific and wide ranging writings. During his lifetime some 18 novels, 10 volumes of poetry, 7 volumes of essays, and countless published writings, commentaries, and reviews kept him in public view (and continue to do so today as much of his writing is still in print in France). His reputation as a writer continues to grow with new biographies, critical writings, and anthologies appearing every year. An explorer of linguistics as well as a mathematician, he often combined his love of both subjects such that the essence of his writings resides not in its "content" but in the sounds and the form of the text. He often argued that the real subject of his work is language itself. Because of this many of his novels, and especially his poems, are virtually impossible to translate into English as they are based on spoken versus literary French, puns, street slang, and complex variations of word play and spelling. *Les Ziaux (Eyeseas)* presents a survey of his poems as written from his early Surrealist days of the 1920's through to 1943 and is representative of Queneau's range of poetic voices."--BOOK JACKET.

Michel Chion is renowned for his explorations of the significance of frequently overlooked elements of cinema, particularly the role of sound. In this inventive and inviting book, Chion considers how cinema has deployed music. He shows how music and film not only complement but also transform each other. The first section of the book examines film music in historical perspective, and the second section addresses the theoretical implications of the crossover between art forms. Chion discusses a vast variety of films across eras, genres, and continents, embracing all the different genres of music that

filmmakers have used to tell their stories. Beginning with live accompaniment of silent films in early movie houses, the book analyzes Al Jolson's performance in *The Jazz Singer*, the zither in *The Third Man*, Godard's patchwork sound editing, the synthesizer welcoming the flying saucer in *Close Encounters of the Third Kind*, and the Kinshasa orchestra in *Felicité*, among many more. Chion considers both original scores and incorporation of preexisting works, including the use and reuse of particular composers across cinematic traditions, the introduction of popular music such as jazz and rock, and directors' attraction to atonal and dissonant music as well as *musique concrète*, of which he is a composer. Wide-ranging and original, *Music in Cinema* offers a welcoming overview for students and general readers as well as refreshingly new and valuable perspectives for film scholars.
