Rapid and effective application of this knowledge can mean the difference between life and death for the animal. Critical care requires the

recognition of subtle changes in the clinical course of animals, and the ability to take corrective action before severe systemic disease becomes irreversible. Clinical decisions regarding seemingly small items, such as fluid therapy, antibiotics or analgesics, can have a profound impact on patient outcome. The main aim of this book is to focus on management of the more common emergency and critical care conditions encountered in clinical
