In the same

way, he was able eventually to compose this extraordinary book. He explains the joy, and deep sadness, of seeing his children and of hearing his aged father's voice on the phone. Again and again he returns to an "inexhaustible reservoir of sensations," keeping in touch with himself and the life around him.
